

BOARD OF HEALTH

Authority to Establish: N. C. General Statute 130A-35

The Board of Health serves as the policy-making, rule-making and adjudicatory body for the Health Department. The Board of Health is composed of 11 members and includes: one physician licensed to practice medicine in the State of North Carolina; one licensed dentist; one licensed optometrist, one licensed veterinarian, one registered nurse, one licensed pharmacist, one county commissioner, one professional engineer, and three representatives of the general public.

The members shall serve three-year terms, and no member may serve more than three consecutive three-year terms.
