

JUVENILE CRIME PREVENTION COUNCIL

Authority to Establish: North Carolina General Statute 143B-543

Purpose: The General Statutes mandate the development of a local JCPC to develop community based alternatives to training school and to proven community based delinquency and substance abuse prevention strategies and programs. It is also the intent of the legislation to provide non-institutional dispositional alternatives for delinquent youth that will provide treatment to the youth and protection of the community.

Membership: The JCPC shall consist of a membership composition as set forth in NCGS 147-33.61 as set forth below with not more than 26 members:

- (1) Local school superintendent or designee
- (2) Local Chief of Police or designee
- (3) Local Sheriff or designee
- (4) District Attorney or designee
- (5) Chief Court Counselor designee
- (6) Director of area mental health or designee.
- (7) The Board of County Commissioners shall modify the JCPC membership as necessary to ensure that council members reflect the racial and socioeconomic diversity of the community and to minimize potential conflicts of interest by members.
