

**ON 2/18/2008, THE UNION COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS VOTED TO SUSPEND OPERATIONS OF THE PUBLIC WORKS ADVISORY BOARD PENDING FURTHER ACTION BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS.**

**PUBLIC WORKS ADVISORY BOARD**

**Purpose:** The purpose of the Advisory Board shall be to review policy issues relative to the County's provision of water, sewer, and solid waste services and to make recommendations to the Board of Commissioners.

**Appointment of Members and Composition of the Advisory Board.** The Advisory Board shall be composed of nine (9) regular members and two alternates, all appointed by the Board of Commissioners. One regular member shall be a resident of each of the County's nine townships with two at large/alternate members.

**Term:** Five (5) initial Advisory Board members and one alternate shall serve one-year terms, and four (4) initial members and one alternate member shall serve two-year terms, as determined by the Board of Commissioners. Thereafter, all members shall serve two-year terms. Except for the terms of initial members, all terms shall begin on January 1. All terms shall expire on December 31 of the last year of the member's term, provided that each member shall serve until his or her successor is appointed. The service of an initial member for less than a full calendar year shall not be counted as part of such member's terms. A member can serve no more than two consecutive terms.

**Duties:** The Advisory Board shall serve in strictly an advisory capacity to the Board of Commissioners for the purpose of making recommendations relative to the establishment, development, revision, and update of the policies outlined in Sections 3.1 through 3.11 of the Guidelines for Union County Public Works Advisory Board. The execution and implementation of policies approved by the Board of Commissioners shall be the responsibility of Public Works' staff. The written recommendations of the Advisory Board shall be forwarded to the Board of Commissioners by Public Works staff, or in the alternative and at the election of the Chairman of the Advisory Board, may be delivered to the Board of Commissioners verbally by the Chairman or his designee from among the Advisory Board members.

**Meetings:** Regular meetings of the Advisory Board shall be conducted at such place and times as agreed by the members, provided that regular meetings shall occur not less frequently than every calendar quarter. Notice of regular meetings shall be provided to the Clerk to the Board of Commissioners. At the present the Board generally meets the second and fourth Tuesdays of each month at 6:00 p.m. in the Personnel Training Room, first floor, Union County Government Center.
