

**Union County Historic Preservation Commission  
Minutes Special Meeting  
October 15, 2012**

The Union County Historic Preservation Commission held a special meeting on Monday, October 15, 2012 in the Union County Commissioners Board Room at the Government Center.

The meeting was called to order at 6:55 pm by Dr. Jerry Surratt, Chairman.

The purpose of the meeting was to hold a joint public hearing with the Board of Union County Commissioners for making a recommendation by the Union County Historic Preservation Commission that the Kerr Family Farm be designated as a local Historic Landmark. The property, owned by Ms. Paulette Kerr, is located at 9619 Joe Kerr Road, Waxhaw, NC 28173.

Chairman Jerry Simpson introduced Dr. Jerry Surratt who made the recommendation. The public hearing was then closed by Chairman Simpson.

Vice Chairman Todd Johnson made motion that an Ordinance be adopted by the Union County Board of Commissioners to designate the Kerr Family Farm as a local Historic Landmark. The vote, by the Union County Commissioners was unanimous.

Mr. Dickerson moved that the meeting of the Union County Historic Preservation Commission be adjourned. Mrs. Crump seconded. The vote was unanimous.
