Veterans Affairs Program to Provide Healthcare Information

January 17, 2011, Monroe, NC – Nurse educators from the rural health program at the W.G. (Bill) Hefner VA Medical Center in Salisbury will conduct health education classes at the VFW Post 2423 at 124 North Indian Trail Road in Indian Trail beginning on Wednesday, Jan. 25.

The health education classes will be held the fourth Wednesday of each month, for six months, beginning Wednesday, Jan. 25 from 10 a.m. – 12 p.m. The classes will focus on diabetes self-management and will last approximately two hours each. Additional time for one-on-one sessions will be allowed at the end of each class. Future class dates are Feb. 22, March 28, April 25, May 23 and June 27. The classes are free of charge.

All veterans currently receiving VA healthcare are encouraged to attend. However, all former and current military members and their family members are invited to attend classes. The team also provides assistance/education on registration and enrollment for VA healthcare.
