Resolution for Permanently Moving Polling Place #21

March 14, 2012, Monroe NC - On Feb. 8, the Union County Board of Elections approved a resolution to permanently transfer voters in Precinct #21 Walkersville Presbyterian Church located at 6204 Brady Road in Waxhaw to the new location at Jackson Volunteer Fire Department located at 8323 Lancaster Highway in Waxhaw.

WHEREAS, General Statute 163-128 provides, among other provisions, that the County Board of Elections shall have power to alter voting places as the local Board deems expedient, by Resolution of the local Board and approval of the Executive Director of the State Board of Elections; and

WHEREAS, the Local Board of Elections has examined the need for a change in the voting location in precinct #21, and deems it expedient and in the best interest of the voters therein to move from the present location at Walkersville Presbyterian Church to Jackson VFD at 8323 Lancaster Highway, Waxhaw, Union County, North Carolina which is within the same precinct; and

Whereas, General Statute 163-128 provides upon such Resolution altering the voting place, 45 days notice shall be provided prior to the next primary or election by advertisement in a local newspaper having general circulation in the county and that the local Board shall not less than 30 days before the next primary or election mail a notice of change to each voter who will be assigned a different voting place;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Union County Board of Elections hereby permanently changes the voting place for Precinct #21 Walkersville Presbyterian Church at 6204 Brady Rd , Waxhaw, Union County, to the Jackson VFD located at 8323 Lancaster Hwy, Waxhaw, Union County, North Carolina;
