Veterans Affairs program to provide Free flu shot, healthcare registration information and more!!!

The W.G. (Bill) Hefner VA Medical Center's rural health team will provide free flu shots to eligible Veterans in the Personnel Training Room on the 1st floor of the Union County Government Center at 500 N. Main Street in Monroe on Wednesday, Oct. 17 from 10 a.m. - 2 p.m. Shots will be available for all veterans currently using VA health care and to those veterans possessing a DD-214 and a valid photo ID.

All former and current military members are encouraged to attend. VA staff will also provide health care registration, education and information services to all non-registered veterans and assist in completing enrollment applications, requesting DD Form 214s, and initiating *MyHealthVet* online services.

Former military members who are not currently enrolled for VA health care benefits will need to bring a copy of their DD Form 214 to attach to their application for VA health care benefits. Veterans who cannot locate their DD Form 214 can request a copy from <http://www.archives.gov/veterans/military-service-records/>.
