

**Minutes
Union County Historic Preservation Commission
5 October 2010**

The Union County Historic Preservation Commission met at 3:30 p.m. on Tuesday, October 5, 2010, in the Heritage Room at the historic Union County Courthouse, Monroe, North Carolina.

Mrs. Bjorlin announced that Al Diehl was not present due to his wife's illness and he has stated that he is resigning from the Historic Preservation Commission. A replacement will be needed for the vacant position. Mrs. Bjorlin mentioned John Dickerson as a possible replacement for Mr. Diehl.

The new commission member from Marshville, Jane Ellickson, was present for her first meeting and was introduced.

Mrs. Bjorlin referred to the agenda concerning the Charles Iceman House circa 1911, 900 West Franklin Street, Monroe, NC. An Application for Designation has been presented by the owners, Rhonda and Macon Griffin.

Mrs. Bjorlin explained the process of designating a property to Mrs. Ellickson and gave her a notebook that is presented to new members with information about the preservation commission. Jason Harpe was suggested to prepare the architectural description for the Iceman House.

An Application for Designation from Unionville Methodist Church has not been received as yet. The booklet, "Designation Procedure" was given to representatives from the church, Lisa Kelley and Lori Warlick, on September 27. Paul Fromberg will be called to see the property if the application is submitted. The historic church is featured in the *Sweet Union* book.

Mrs. Bjorlin explained to Mrs. Ellickson that, hopefully, a museum will be established here in the courthouse.

With a quorum not being present, the members left the meeting.

The next meeting will be November 2, 2010, at 3:30 p.m. in the Heritage Room.
