Have you recently painted and have leftover latex paint? Do you wish to recycle that extra paint and help others in the community? Here is your opportunity.

Union County Public Works and Habitat for Humanity have teamed together to accept used latex paint that will be used for future Habitat for Humanity projects or sold in its ReStore.



Paint Donation Guidelines

Latex paint must be less than 3 years old	Paint containers must be at least half full
All paints cans must have secure lids	No leaking or rusty cans accepted
Paints must not have any solidification	Can may be checked and rejected

Disposing of Latex Paint

If your paint doesn't meet the donation guidelines, add cat litter to latex paint in the can (1:1 ratio) and stir into the paint until it has an oatmeal-like consistency. Let it dry for one day and place into garbage can with lid off for proper disposal.

You may also pour paint into a paper box top or shallow plastic tub. Pour in 1/2-inch layers and allow paint to dry (one day for each layer). Adding cat litter, oil dry or shredded paper speeds up the process. Repeat until paint is used up and dry. Throw away when complete. Dispose of empty paint can with lid off.
