Union County residents can drop off the following items:

Household Hazardous Waste (HHW):

oil-base paints, solvents, herbicides, pesticides, insecticides cleaners, household chemicals, household batteries, cooking oil, grease and fluorescent bulbs

Electronics:

computers, laptops, printers, VCRs, mobile phones, TVs, microwaves, vacuums, electronic games, anything with an electric motor, plug or computer chip

Paper Shredding Service: shred your personal documents, limit 5 boxes

Used Motor Oil: limit 5 gallons **Oil Filters:** limit 10

Tires: off the rim, limit 10 **Batteries:** lead-acid batteries

Items not accepted:

ammunition, gun powder, explosives, radioactive materials, bio-infectious materials, pharmaceuticals, and smoke detectors.
