### **Community Meetings to be Held to Discuss Roundabouts**

The second meeting to discuss roundabouts on NC 200 will be held July 11 at the Jackson Volunteer Fire Department Community Room, located at 8623 Lancaster Highway, Waxhaw, NC 28173 from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. Information will be available about the roundabout projects along N.C. 200 at Providence Road South, Potter Road, McWhorter Road and N.C. 522.
