Public Information Meetings Scheduled for the Yadkin Regional Water Supply Project

MONROE, N.C. (October 8, 2018) – Union County is excited to invite the community to attend public information meetings on the Yadkin Regional Water Supply Project later this month. The open-house style meetings will summarize recent progress and share next steps on the Project, which recently entered its design-build phase. Project design is expected to near completion by summer 2019, with construction anticipated to begin in fall 2019.

The public information meetings are scheduled for:

- Wednesday, October 24 at the Norwood Community Building, located at 247 West Turner Street, Norwood, NC 28128 – 5:00 – 7:30 PM
- Thursday, October 25 at the Long Street Community Building, 519 N Long Street, Oakboro, NC 28129 – 5:00 – 7:30 PM

The meetings will have a drop-in format with no formal presentation, and the information at all three will be the same.

The Town of Norwood and Union County have partnered to develop the Yadkin Regional Water Supply project. This project will include a new water intake and pump station at Lake Tillery in Norwood and water transmission pipelines to bring water to current and future service areas in Union County's Yadkin River Basin, the Town of Norwood and Stanly County.
